Cultivate Diverse Workplaces and Communities

Caution! Employee Retention Credit

Many nonprofits are being solicited by groups offering to file for the Earned Income Credit (ERC), charging a fee of just 10% for their assistance. While some of these companies may be reputable, you must be cautious as we have learned that some will incorrectly file for the maximum credit.

The problem shows up later if the agency learns they did not qualify for all or most of the credit. The inflated 10% fee has already been paid and the group that processed the application is no longer. So the advice is to be sure to go with a reputable, known local firm, many that also charge just 10% but collect AFTER you get the credit



Charitable Solicitation Registration

Did you know that nonprofits are required to register in states where they solicit donations?

In Kentucky, registration is due annually by 4 months and 15

days after the organization's fiscal year ends. <u>Learn</u> more.

In Ohio, annual reports are due on the 15th day of the fifth

month following the end of the organization's fiscal year. **Learn more.** To file in Ohio, visit Attorney General's

5-week Salesforce Boot Camp

Dates: May 8, 10, 15, 17 and 22, 1:00-5:00 pm; In-person Application deadline is April 21

Are you struggling to find time to manage your volunteers and donors? Is your organization looking for ways to both save time and level-up your operational processes? Salesforce is a CRM (customer relationship management) solution that will allow your organization to track all clients, donors, volunteers, and organizational contacts in one platform. Through Salesforce, you can automate communication and project management processes, and reduce duplication of staff effort.

OneSource Center is hosting a five-week intensive Salesforce Bootcamp in May. Participating organizations will receive 10 user licenses free in perpetuity and 20+ hours of hands-in, in-person, technical training for a one time flat fee of \$3500. This is FREE software and support for life and includes an in-kind training grant of \$10,000.

Organizations will also receive the added benefit of a peer-to-peer learning environment, and support to upload existing data into the platform at the completion of the Bootcamp.
