Annual Review of Donor Restrictions

Shoppers in our Marketplace are asked to sign an agreement to guarantee that goods purchased help those in need and ensure that donor's specific requirements for distribution of goods are met.



Please be sure that you alert your staff members making purchases at OneSource Center of Good 360 instructions that stipulate:

- donated goods are to be used only for people in need
- · items are not to be resold or returned to the store for credit
- products may not be used in fundraising activities
- items are not given to agency volunteers or staff.

Please review the entire agreement with your staff who visit our Marketplace.

Catholic Campaign for Human Development grants. Religious and secular organizations within the geographic area of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati can apply for Catholic Campaign for Human Development grants (\$5,000 to \$10,000) through the Catholic Social Action Office. Applications are due March 15, 2019 and the grant cycle runs from July 1 to June 30. This is a great opportunity if your agency is doing work that addresses poverty issues.

Andrew Jergens Foundation grant. The Foundation's prime interest is the health, education, cultural experiences and social welfare of children in the Greater Cincinnati area. Deadline for submission is February 15, 2019.

Spirit of Construction grant. Grant priorities are for those organizations involved in higher learning, work force development and local interest projects. Deadline: February 15, 2019.
