The "Ins and Outs" of Diversity and Inclusion

NOTE: Starting with the January 2019 offering, OneSource Center's "Building Blocks" monthly seminars will be held at OneSource Center's spacious and beautifully appointed Park 42 Conference Center in Sharonville, just minutes from the Sharonville 275 exit.

Presentation Details: Learn how to develop processes and support behaviors that underscore the important topics of diversity and inclusion in your organization – steps that can create a positive environment and impact on your corporate culture, employees and consumers. The session will include clear definitions of diversity and inclusion, and help attendees identify the work that needs to be done for your organization to understand and recognize how unconscious bias and other behaviors create barriers for an inclusive environment. The workshop will increase awareness of how everyone can appreciate and accept all dimensions of diversity.

Presenter: Gail Manley is Director of Diversity and Inclusion with Fidelity Investments where she coaches 150 Employee Resource Groups globally, presenting diversity curricula to all levels of leadership. She also serves as a debrief facilitator and coach to Fidelity senior management. Gail is best known for her leadership development programs, diversity training, coaching skills and for her expertise in talent management and relationship building. Gail is an active participant in the Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber where she had a leading role in shaping "Diverse by Design" programming. She also sits on the CONNECT Senior Leader Council, developed training

materials for Regional Youth Education, and is a coach for women who re-enter the workplace at Dress for Success.

Religious and secular organizations within the geographic area of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati can apply for Catholic Campaign for Human Development grants (\$5,000 to \$10,000) through the Catholic Social Action Office.
