Hamilton County Commissioners have authorized up to \$250,000 in federal American Rescue Plan Act funds to support grassroots organizations committed to providing opportunities to improve the well-being of young people. The Inspire Youth Initiative provides grants of up to \$5,000 to community-based organizations, neighborhood groups, churches, nonprofits, youth groups, and others to help provide activities that improve the physical, mental, and social health of Hamilton County youth in low- to moderate-income communities.
