### Nonprofits Welcome to Explore



Newcomers to the OneSource Center's warehouse are often amazed at the incredible array of discounted furniture and retail offerings available to nonprofits -- all for a fraction of the cost of retail! We are the only one of our kind in the region for nonprofits, and we love to spread the word.

If you have never been to OneSource Center -- How about a field trip on Nonprofit Shopping Day, the last

Wednesday of the month? (The next Nonprofit Shopping Day is <u>March 27</u>.) Details of the open shopping day are <u>here</u>. Reasonably priced <u>memberships</u> are available to 501c3 organizations for year-round, weekday access to the warehouse, but many organizations take advantage of the Nonprofit Shopping Day to become familiar with offerings.

What can you expect when you visit? Lobby furniture, desks, office chairs, file cabinets, shelving units and conference room tables are all donated by corporations and then these items are made available to nonprofits at a fraction of the cost of retail! In the Marketplace area, visitors fill their carts with bed linens, household items, office supplies, pet supplies or even a piece of art to hang on their agency's wall. A wide range of items are available. It is not unusual for us to receive donations of room dividers, lockers, children's toys or medical equipment to name a few items. OneSource Center partners with an organization called Good 360 that channels corporate retail donations to its member redistribution centers -- and we are that center in the region. You never know what we might be getting in!

### **ADVANCE Management Class**

Investing in the management skill development of entry to middle-level managers is one that can reap huge awards. No matter the management level -- being a

great leader takes the right mix of skills -- to engage, motivate and coordinate a team.



OneSource Center supports the importance of this education, and partners with NLIGC to offer the ADVANCE training, a three-month management and leadership development

program for nonprofit employees who have been in a management position for at least six months but no longer than four years.

OneSource Center volunteer facilitators provide background on all topics, and encourage peer-to-peer learning. The ADVANCE class is offered four times a year, with the next session beginning April 3.

Through a series of six interactive, hands-on workshops, participants review.

- An introduction to emotional intelligence
- How to assess and manage workplace conflict
- Effective communication principles
- · Managing up, down, and laterally and
- Leadership principles and styles.

The next session of ADVANCE begins April 3. Applications are accepted on the NLIGC website, and a link is available on the <u>OneSource website</u>. All sessions are held at the Talbert House Executive Offices, 2600 Victory Parkway, Cincinnati, from 9 a.m. to noon.

**Catholic Campaign for Human Development grants.** Religious and secular organizations within the geographic area of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati can apply for

Catholic Campaign for Human Development grants (\$5,000 to \$10,000) through the Catholic Social Action Office. Applications for local funding are due March 15, 2019 and the grant cycle runs from July 1 to June 30. This is a great opportunity if your agency is doing work that addresses poverty issues.

Duke Energy: Powerful Communities Grant Duke Energy Foundation's "Creating Powerful Communities" grants support local communities with over \$30 million in charitable grants each year. Multiple grant applications are available. The "Powerful Communities: Workforce" grant is due April 30.
