
The new location has easy interstate and city access, has plenty of parking, and is in a light industrial area (very similar to our current location.)

The Coronavirus has everyone concerned as all sectors plan for how best to respond in light of continuing updates and response recommendations. At this point, OneSource

## Techsoup's Tech Training for Nonprofits

Get the "Tech Training Your Nonprofit Has Been Asking for (and That You'll Actually Want to Take)" on Tue, Mar 17, 2020 2 pm EST. A recent survey conducted by Microsoft found that more than 60 percent of nonprofit respondents desired more IT training. This webinar will provide a crash course in all of the nonprofit-specific training courses that have been developed by TechSoup and Microsoft to help nonprofit learners get the most out of the tools they already have. Courses in Techsoup's Digital Skills Center range from introductory

courses in Excel to advanced courses in Power BI and are packed with use cases and cover popular applications like Word, PowerPoint, Teams, Power BI, and PowerApps. The

courses focus on "microlearning," in which learning objectives are delivered in bite-size portions that are instructionally more effective. The format also allows courses to double as on-the-job support materials.

#### **First-time Home Ownership Classes**

Do your clients know about this program designed to give first-time homeowners the chance to learn about the home purchasing process? A new reduced price program from Brighton Center's Financial Wellness Department and sponsored by PNC Bank offers several learning options to individuals including evening and weekend classes which include free reference materials and a financial coach. lending concepts, real estate contracts and home inspections. Once the full course is completed, graduates receive a certificate of completion that can be presented to a lender as evidence of skills learned.

**Zonta Grant.** Zonta Club Cincinnati will award four \$500 grants. Applying organizations/projects must be aligned with the mission, goals and strategies of Zonta International and the ZCC which relates to women and children's health, education and advocacy. Applications due April 1.

**GCF:** Supporting Educational Success GCF has a dynamic history of investing in educational success throughout our eight-county region. We live in a region with sizable disparities by race and economic status, and educational attainment has proven to be a primary means of advancement in our society. RFPs should explicitly address the following purposes: To support in and/or out of school educational efforts that reduce disparities in educational and career attainment for students of color and/or those of low socioeconomic status; or that increase social-emotional learning and health for those students. Deadline April 3.

**Rotary Foundation of Cincinnati** The Rotary Foundation of Cincinnati provides the funding and resources necessary to support the diverse humanitarian efforts of the Rotary Club of Cincinnati. Its primary goal is to support children, particularly those whose future development is impaired by physical, cultural, emotional, financial and social obstacles. To accomplish this goal, the Rotary Foundation of Cincinnati actively solicits and awards grants to non-profit organizations. Deadline April 3.

**UW Black Empowerment Works Grant** Black Empowerment Works promotes Black economic and social prosperity through self-determination by resourcing and funding grassroots-generated, Black-led ideas, programs and projects. Essentially, it is an equity-focused grant and support program addressing poverty in Greater Cincinnati. Deadline April 13.

**Duke Energy: Workforce Development and Training Grants.** These grants support workforce development programs that address the most pressing skills gaps in local communities. Programs cultivating the energy-sector's future workforce will be given priority in this grant cycle. Programs serving under-represented, low-income or diverse audiences, including women and minorities, will be given preference in this grant cycle. Deadline April 30.


