ADVANCE Program

ADVANCE strengthens and develops management and leadership skills for first-time nonprofit managers or individuals who need to grasp leadership basics to fulfill their responsibilities. Through a combination of lectures and peer-directed learning, this six-week series provides the time for participants to practice and receive feedback on working in diverse environments, communication skills, conflict management styles, leadership approaches and more. The training consists of six 3-hour sessions, one session every other week. All sessions are from 9 a.m. until 12 p.m. and are normally held at the Talbert House Executive Office at 2600 Victory Parkway, Cincinnati, Ohio.

EXCEL Program

The EXCEL program is a nine-month leadership development and skills training program for nonprofit executives leading or preparing to lead nonprofit organizations in the Greater Cincinnati region. OneSource Center for Nonprofit Excellence provides faculty and coaches for EXCEL participants along with guest speakers with specific expertise in particular topics. Applications are accepted in the late Spring. The program runs from September through May with monthly interactive learning sessions covering an extensive list of management topics.
