#### Free or Reduced Cost Health Insurance

Spread the word! Thousands of Greater Cincinnati residents qualify for free or reduced cost health insurance through plans available on <a href="HealthCare.gov">HealthCare.gov</a>. Open enrollment, which runs through Dec. 15, is the only time to enroll in or change coverage in a federal health care marketplace plan, commonly referred to as Obamacare.

#### **Grant Aimed at Healthy Eating**

The purpose of the Foundation is to provide grants to nonprofit organizations within the areas of education and scholarships, health wellness and scientific research, welfare of children, sports, fine and performing arts, animal welfare and environmental and community stewardship in the Greater Cincinnati Tri-state area.

Letters of Intent for **Impact 100** are due December 13 at noon. The organization focuses on nonprofits in the Greater Cincinnati Tri-state area. Grants are in the area of culture, environment, family, health and wellness and education.
