OneSource Center Highlight: The Value of Collaboration

Successful collaborative partnerships allow nonprofits to create stronger combined impact in communities. By identifying a common goal and working together, we can make an even larger difference in the populations we serve. Several examples show the many benefits of working together for the greater good.

The Down Syndrome Association of Greater Cincinnati (DSAGC) held their golf outing in June with the Ken Anderson Alliance (KAA), at the Maketewah Country Club. The event reached full capacity and one of the main keys to success was collaboration. This is evident in the fact that the event doubled in profits since the partnership began in 2018, now raking in upwards of \$200k.

Another example of a successful collaboration is with i-SPACE and Gorman Heritage Farm. When these two organizations needed space, they formed the strategic partnership of Soil and Stars as an umbrella organization that owns the facility they share. Both organizations serve the same aged youth and have

benefited from the close proximity and cross-pollination of programming. Funders have looked favorably on nonprofits that collaborate!

Attention Kentucky Nonprofits: Team Kentucky Nonprofit Assistance Fund has half of the \$75 million allocated still available. Designed to help with pandemic-related economic recovery, qualifying Kentucky nonprofits can get up to \$100,000 in one-time direct relief, with no restrictions on how funds must be spent and no reporting requirements. Applications are considered first come, first served so there is value in applying early. Application deadline is October 1.

Butler Foundation: Our mission is to respond as directly as possible to our neighbors in need by addressing the entanglements of poverty, primarily in Northern Kentucky. Application deadline is October 1.

PNC Charitable Trust: Grants are awarded to eligible nonprofit organizations from nearly 200 perpetual charitable trusts and private foundations for which PNC is trustee. Application deadline is October 1.

The Erma A. Bantz Foundation: The Foundation supports various organizations that have as one of their stated purposes the support of and/or aid to the visually impaired and the hearing impaired. Sixty percent of the assets of the Foundation will be devoted to Visually Impaired Organizations and forty percent of the assets of the Foundation will be devoted to Hearing Impaired Organizations. LOI due October 1.

City of Cincinnati Office of Environmental Sustainability: Matching grants for building owners to lower utility costs. Application deadline is October 1.

Impact 100 has Letter of Intent training, Q&A and Nonprofit Panel Discussion sessions in October to prepare for applying for their grant. **Learn more**
