Throughout her Air Force career, she frequently was recognized for her leadership, including the AFMC/PK Professional Development Award in 2019, Supervisor of the Year in 2017, and Civilian of the Year in 2010. Cecelia's skills include agile management, strategic planning, organizational improvement, coaching, and team building.

Strongly promoting empowerment, Cecelia has taught job development and interviewing skills, established and chaired a business council of Dayton businesses to provide job placement for trainees in the metropolitan area, and taught economics.

Her mentoring passion developed over time as a volunteer mentor for Parity, Inc, a partnership between Air Force Materiel Command (AFMC) and the Dayton Urban League/City Schools; developing women and college candidates as a member of the American Business Women's Association; and teaching small groups about working with others, through her church.
